Prevention 101- Versions Available for Adults, Grade 4-6, or 6-12

Provides a general overview of ways to prevent drug and alcohol use and misuse. It covers a variety of topics from identification, refusal skills, and risk and protective factors.

Recommended: Request this presentation first to create a foundation to build on in further presentations.

A Guide to Social Media- Versions Available for Adults or Grades 6-12

Provides comprehensive overview of how social media can negatively or positively impact adolescents. It also touches on ways to disconnect from social media, cyberbullying, how social media is connected to drug and alcohol use, as well as resources to apps that boost mental health and well-being.

The Brain and Body- Only Available in Adult Version

Provides an introduction to how drugs and alcohol work in the body, as well as the physiological processes of addiction and recovery.

Cannabis and Vaping- Versions Available for Adults or Grades 6-12

This presentation is a comprehensive overview of the various forms of cannabis as well as how cannabis affects the body and the brain. This presentation also encompasses the warning signs and risks of vaping with tobacco and cannabis use.

The Opioid Epidemic- Versions Available for Adults or Grades 6-12

This presentation looks at the different types of opioids (legal, illegal, synthetic), the risks of opioid use and misuse, warning signs, how to talk about it, and ways to prevent misuse.

Narcan Training- Only Available in Adult Version

This is a training for organizations that are requesting Narcan for use and distribution. Training will cover Narcan and its ability to reverse opioid overdose, as well as how to administer in an emergency. Narcan will be distributed to participants/organization after training is complete.
